

WWCM is running extremely low on their inventory of all non-perishable food items for the food

pantry. The number of families using the WWCM pantry has increased from around 250/month 1Q 2023 to around 400 families/month for the 1Q 2024. WWCM needs canned vegetables, canned fruit, canned meats (tuna, chicken, etc.), soups & ramen, pasta, pasta sauce, canned tomato products, cereals, rice, beans, macaroni & cheese, side items, peanut butter & jelly, crackers, etc. Please

\$185,546 of excess revenues from the prior two fiscal years are available to fund the current operations in fiscal year 2023-24.

Deferred mortgage payments NOT included above.

As of February 2024, early payments to the Forward Capital Campaign totaling \$1,425,162 have allowed us to repay the lender the total balance of the deferred amounts plus an additional \$485,368. This reduces our total debt to \$3.75 million which remains due by February 2035.
