

Holleman's Bequest

Due to the generosity and forethought of Ruth Holleman, Apex United Methodist Church received a bequest of \$100,000 for missions - specifically for the Simple Gifts Community Garden, Apex Immigration Services, Refugee Care, and Strategic Missions. Her bequest is a fitting tribute to a woman who was an avid gardener and advocate for immigrants and refugees.



Excerpts from Ruth Holleman Obituary -

Ruth was born June 10, 1924 in Sampson County, NC. She was preceded in death by her husband, Carl Holleman.

A graduate of Westbrook High School, Mary Elizabeth Hospital School of Nursing, and the Nurse Anesthesia Program, Bowman Gray School of Medicine/North Carolina Baptist Hospital. Ruth served as chair of Rex Hospital's Department of Anesthesia and later as nurse anesthetist for Dorothea Dix Hospital. She also provided volunteer anesthesia services for St. Agnes Hospital, Central Prison, and Butner Hospital.

Ruth provided leadership and service in many civic, cultural, and church activities. While Chair of the Wake County Library Commission (1994-2004), the county constructed eight new libraries, renovated three others, put bookmobiles back in service for children with limited access to libraries, upgraded to computerized cataloging, installed personal computers for the public, and established the audio book collection.

Ruth served as President of the Democratic Women of Wake County, the Apex Women's Club, and the PTA, and as Director of the North Carolina University Women's Club Foreign Student English Conversation program. She served as a docent for the North Carolina Museum of Art and on the boards of Wake County Legal Aid, Wake County Historical Society, Friends of the College, and Raleigh Boys Choir. She was a long-time Sunday school teacher and Cub Scout Den Mother.

Ruth was a pioneer for women, creating a path for those seeking careers and positions of leadership.

Ruth joined the church triumphant on May 16, 2011. She set up her estate so that her generosity would benefit organizations over time and we are grateful to be a part of her legacy.

MISSION UPDATE Family Promise of the Triangle

Family Promise of the Triangle has gone through a lot of changes since the pandemic, leaving many of our supporters and faith community partners asking if we've been able to serve as many families as we used to under our old model. We're happy to report that in 2022, Family Promise served a record-breaking 119 families! Last year, we had to close our Emergency Shelter units for two months for renovations. While we were happy to see these old apartments get much-needed repairs, we were concerned that it would have a negative impact on the amount of families we would be able to serve in 2023. However, we surpassed our expectations and set a new record by serving 127 families! In the coming weeks, we will be sending our supporters our annual report that will go into more detail about our impact in

2023. In the meantime, we wanted to thank you for your support for Family Promise of the Triangle. Without your donations, participation in our meal rotation, and regular volunteering, our families wouldn't have been able to thrive the way they have in the last year. 
GENERAL FUND OFFERINGS: July 1, 2023 - March 31, 2024

\$185,546 of excess revenues from the prior two fiscal years are available to fund the current operations in fiscal year 2023-24.

Deferred mortgage payments NOT included above.

As of February 2024, early payments to the Forward Capital Campaign totaling \$1,509,734 have allowed us to repay the lender the total balance of the deferred amounts plus an additional \$556,458. This reduces our total debt to \$3.67 million which remains due by February 2035.
